

LICENCE TO OPERATE A FORKLIFT TRUCK

This course leads to the LF Class High-Risk Work (HRW) Forklift Licence as defined in the National Standards for "Licensing Persons Performing High-Risk Work. The course is suitable to all operators working in warehouse, transport, construction, events and retail.

This course is based on the National Standard for Licensing Persons Performing High Risk Work and it satisfied territory and state licensing requirements. Legislation requires Forklift refresher training every five (5) years.

TP TRAINING PTY LTD ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Be 18 years of age and above
- Have physical ability to demonstrate required tasks
- Adequate literacy & numeracy skills
- Unique Student Identifier (USI) Number
- Bring 100 points of Identification (Evidence of Identity table listed)

EVIDENCE OF IDENTITY

PRIMARY DOCUMENTS (70 POINTS)

- Australian Birth Certificate/card issued by Registers of Births Deaths and Marriages
- Passport – Australian or International (current or expired within last two years, but not cancelled)
- Australian Citizenship Certificate

SECONDARY DOCUMENTS (40 POINTS)

- Current Australian state or territory driver's licence or learner driver licence /permit
- Current Australian state or territory boat operators photo licence (e.g. personal watercraft driving licence)
- Current NSW firearms photo licence
- Current Australian issued high-risk work licence
- Current Australian state/territory proof of age or photocard (e.g. a Service NSW issued photo card)
- Australian Police or Dept of Defence card (with photo)

OTHER DOCUMENTS (25 POINTS)

- Department of Veterans Affairs card
- Current Centrelink card
- Property (council) rates notice issued in the last three (3) months
- Property lease agreement
- Home insurance papers
- Utility bills – e.g. water, electricity, gas issued in the last three (3) months
- Telephone account issued in the last three (3) months
- Current Medicare card
- Current motor vehicle registration
- Credit/savings Bank statements
- Motor Vehicle insurance papers
- Credit/savings cards
